

MARIA SOPHIE DOROTHEA FIEBIG formerly ARNOLD nee PARBS

- 7 April 1826 Wilhelm born in Silesia
- 1836 Maria Sophie Dorothea Parbs born
- October 1854 Wilhelm arrives in Adelaide with Carl Friedrich
- 19 January 1857 Wilhelm marries Maria Sophie Dorothea Parbs at Bethany
- 17 January 1859 Wilhelm purchases 40 acres at Siegersdorf (Section 74) from Johann Joachim Parbs for 200 Pds
- 1 July 1861 Wilhelm sells Siegersdorf property for 300 Pds and moves to Greenock
- 2 June 1863 Wilhelm purchases Pt Section 7597 Belvidere & Light – 141 acres on Kapunda Rd near Greenock for 700 Pds
- 20 March 1868 Wilhelm dies intestate
- 1 October 1869 Maria (aged 32 years) marries Johann Gottfried Wilhelm Fiebig (aged 23 years) at Bethany
- 1870 Son of Maria & Wilhelm, Carl Wilhelm is confirmed at Tarnma Lutheran Church (Tarnma is Friedrichswald near Point Pass – between Eudunda & Saddleworth)
- 29 April 1871 Court case because of no will & land put up to public auction. Ehrenfried buys at auction for 497 Pds
- 1872 Maria & Gottfried Fiebig move to Hamilton near Peters Hill (near Riverton)
- 1876 Maria & Gottfried Fiebig move to Terowie (Peterborough district)**
- Dates unknown Maria bears several children including Rudolph Fiebig.
- 6 April 1882 Rudolph George Fiebig at Booleroo Centre (baptism or birth or whatever ???)
- 20 April 1882 Maria dies (date not confirmed) *Death certificate says 25th April 1882,*
- Date unknown Johann Gottfried Wilhelm Fiebig remarries
- 23 February 1891 Son of Maria & Wilhelm, Carl Wilhelm Arnold, marries Johanna Gutte at Caltowie
- 28 May 1891 Carl Wilhelm's son August born at Appila
- 1893 Wilhelm at Tarcowie (Sands & Mc Dougall directory)
- 1896 Wilhelm, Henry & Rudolph farmers at Tarcowie (Sands & Mc Dougall directory)
- 1900 to 1902 August farmer at Tarcowie, Henry farmer at Tothill's Creek, Friedrichswald, J A farmer at Rhine Villa, Rudolph postmaster/storekeeper One Tree Hill
- 17 July 1916 Johann Gottfried Wilhelm Fiebig dies aged 70 and is buried at Pekina Lutheran cemetery (5 km east of Booleroo Centre)
